



Training of the Examiner

Recommendations

1. Minimum conditions for access to the training of examiner:

a. An examiner has to hold a licence in the category he wants to become examiner in

b. An entry test is compulsory (for all categories)

c. **Minimum age:** 25 years

Minimum education: secondary school

Minimum driving licence: a category B driving licence

Minimum driving experience: 5 years

d. **Specialisation:**

Category A:

1 year B examiner or 5 years possession of a category A driving licence

Category C, D, E:

- Minimum age: 28 years 3 years examiner

- category B, or 5 years possession of a driving licence C/D

2. Minimum training period:

Category B: 6 weeks

Specialisation:

- **Category A:** 1 week

- **Category C, D, E:** 2 weeks

3. Permanent education:

Period: 10% of the basic training, that is:

Category B: 3 days (or 24 hours)

Specialisation:

- **Category A:** half a day (or 4 hours)

- **Category C, D, E:** one day (or 8 hours)

The hours can be filled in according to the individual needs of an examiner.

Contents: parts of the basic training

4. Quality Control:

An audit of 8 hours per year.

Complaints, administrative information (and data on accidents, etc.) will be used as a basis.
