She teaches Developmental Psychology, Research Methods, and Group Theory and Practice for Bachelor level students at university, Advanced Topics of Research Methodology in Psychology for Master level students. Her research interests are issues and difficulties of adolescence, problem behaviour in adolescence and adulthood. Most of current research pieces are dedicated to the topic of traffic psychology, mainly personality and attitudinal predictors of risky driving in young novice drivers, psychological changes during standard driving training, hazard perception in young and older drivers etc. Together with colleagues she published more than 30 scientific articles and two books. Laura actively participates in many national and international research projects. She is a member of CADROSA (Consortium of Adolescent Road Safety) and TPI (Traffic Psychology International). She serves as Co-Editor of peer-reviewed journal International Journal of Psychology: A Biopsychosocial Approach.
