






FLEET OF VEHICLES IN MILLION 30.855.945

CATEGORY AM LICENSE

PAST

■ LCC issued 14 years old. Only theory test

PRESENT





- Authorises the driving of two and three-wheel vehicles and light quadricycles.
- Minimum Age: Until 01.09.2010.-14 years old and after this date, 15 years old.
- To carry a passenger: 18 years old.
- AM limited to tricycles and quadricycles. National code 107





CATEGORY A1 LICENSE

PAST AND PRESENT



■ Authorises the driving of:

- Motorcycles with or without a sidecar with a:
 - -Cylinder capacity not exceeding 125 c/c
 - -Power not exceeding 11 kW
 - -Power/weight ratio not exceeding 0.1 kW/kg
- Motor tricycles with a power not exceeding 15 kW.

The issue of the A1 involves AM

Minimum Age: 16 years old





CATEGORY A2 LICENSE

NEW CATEGORY



- ■Authorises the driving of motorcycles with:
 - Power not exceeding 35 kW
 - Power/weight ratio not exceeding 0.2 kW/kg and
 - Not derived from a vehicle of more than double its power

Minimum Age to obtain license: 18 years old.

Motor tricycles with a power exceeding 15 kw may not be driven.





ISSUING OF A2 LICENSE

DIRECT Access (without experience).

PROGRESSIVE Access (with experience)

Tests to be taken:

- 1.-General and specific theory.
- 2.-Skills Test: Manoeuvres in an off road area. + Driving test on open roads.

Two years as a holder of an A1 license

And passing the driving test.

The <u>driving test</u> examination on open roads.





CATEGORY A LICENSE

Category A

■ Motorcycles, Tricycles and cuadricycles



PAST

Limited to 25 Kw and 0.16 Kw/Kg.

Minimum age: 18 years old.

Without limitation, Two years as a holder of an A limited license.

PRESENT

Motorcycles and motor tricycles without any restriction

Minimum age to obtain license: 20 years old

Tricycles with a power exceeding 15 Kw may not be driven until the age of twenty-one.





ISSUING OF A LICENSE

DIRECT Access (without experience).

At present, this is not possible in Spain.

PROGRESSIVE Access (with experience)

- -Two years as a holder of an A2 license (20 years old)
- -Pass a training course under the conditions that will be set out by Ministry of the Interior Order before December 2011.





TRAINING COURSE (1)

Theoretycal and practical course:

- -The centre will be authorized by DGT.
- -Classes:10 hours.
- -20 students per course.
- -Motorcycles of A category.
- -An off road area to practice the manoeuvres.
- Certificate of the centre if the student passes the course.





TRAINING COURSE (2)

a) Training course: theoretycal and practical.


Theory course: 10 hours.

Practical course: certification of 2000 km driving in open

roads.

b) + Test by DGT:

Carry out a spiral, maintaining an uniform speed, moving at 30 km/h, on a track with 1,5 m, carrying out concentric circles before going on in open road during at least 25 minutes
